Cal Puts on Rush, 31-22

TEMPE (UPI)—California turned to its previously unproven ground attack to offset a sub-par passing game by Joe Roth and take a 31-22 victory over Arizona State Saturday night.

Markey Crane, with a pair of touchdowns and 102 yards, and Tom Newton, with 97 yards, paced the Bears' ground attack which had totaled only 137 yards in its first two games, both losses.

With Roth passing just often enough to loosen up ASU's defense, the Bears scored all four touchdowns by running. Roth, averaging 24 completions a game, completed 10 of 27 for 104 yards and was burned early when John Harris intercepted a deflected pass and returned it 47 yards for the Sun Devil's only first half score.
